About this Dashboard

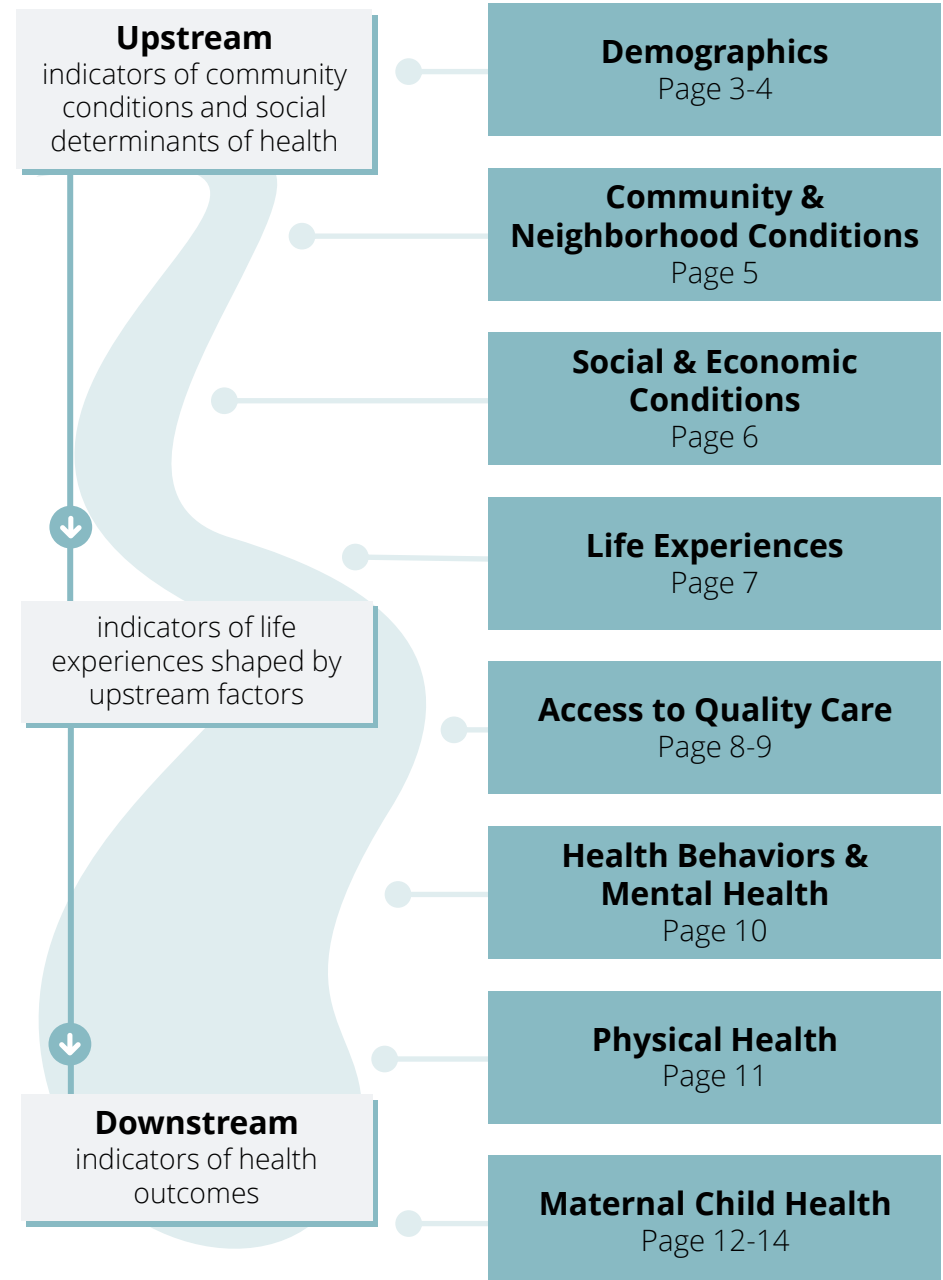
The Region 6 Health Equity Dashboard gives a clear picture of maternal and infant health in Genesee, Huron, Lapeer, Sanilac, Shiawassee, St. Clair, and Tuscola Counties. It shows how some groups have worse health outcomes than others.

Infant and maternal death rates tell us about the health of the whole community. Differences in these rates among different groups or areas show deeper problems. These problems come from social conditions that give some groups more advantages and resources than others.

The dashboard uses data to show how community conditions affect health. It helps find ways to fix these problems and make communities and individuals healthier. The data is organized from "upstream" causes, like social and economic conditions, to "downstream" outcomes, like health behaviors, illness, and death. For example, poverty, limited healthcare, poor education, and unsafe housing can lead to higher infant death rates and health problems.

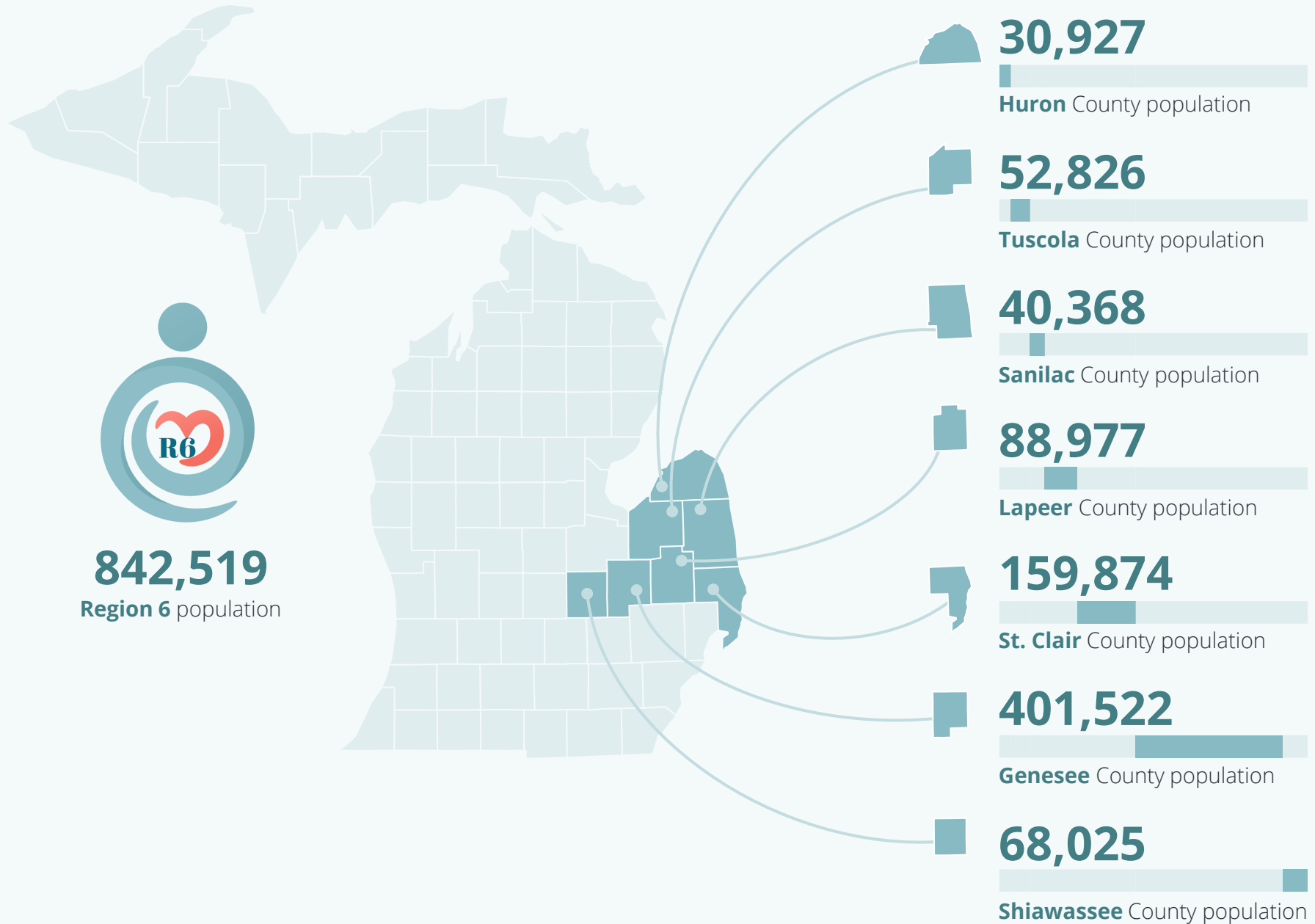
The goal of this dashboard is to show that health differences exist in Region 6 and to encourage everyone, from policymakers to community members, to work together to make positive changes.

The types of data included in the dashboard were inspired by similar efforts by the Southeast Michigan Perinatal Quality Improvement Coalition. Data were chosen based on how severe the differences are, how available the data is, and how easy it is to compare. The data are all publicly available or were requested from the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services and other teams. You can find details about the data sources at the end of this dashboard.

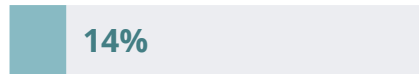

Average Miles to Birthing Hospital

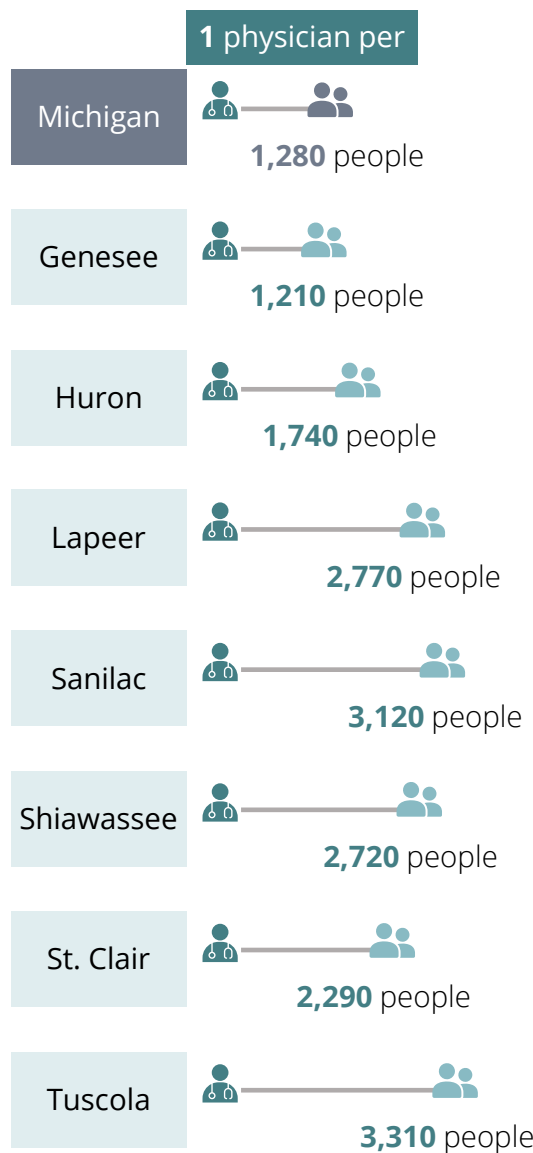

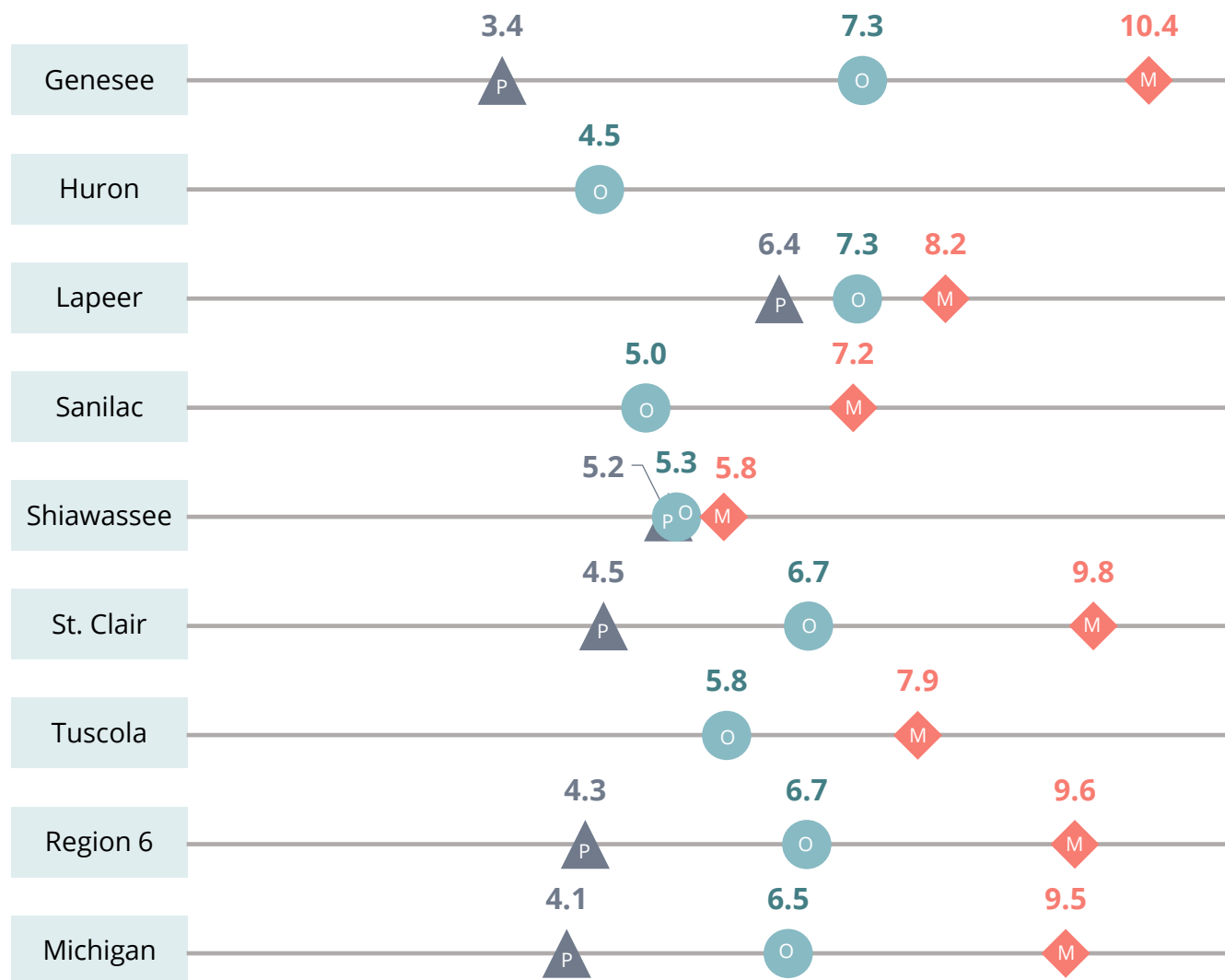

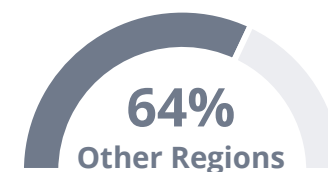

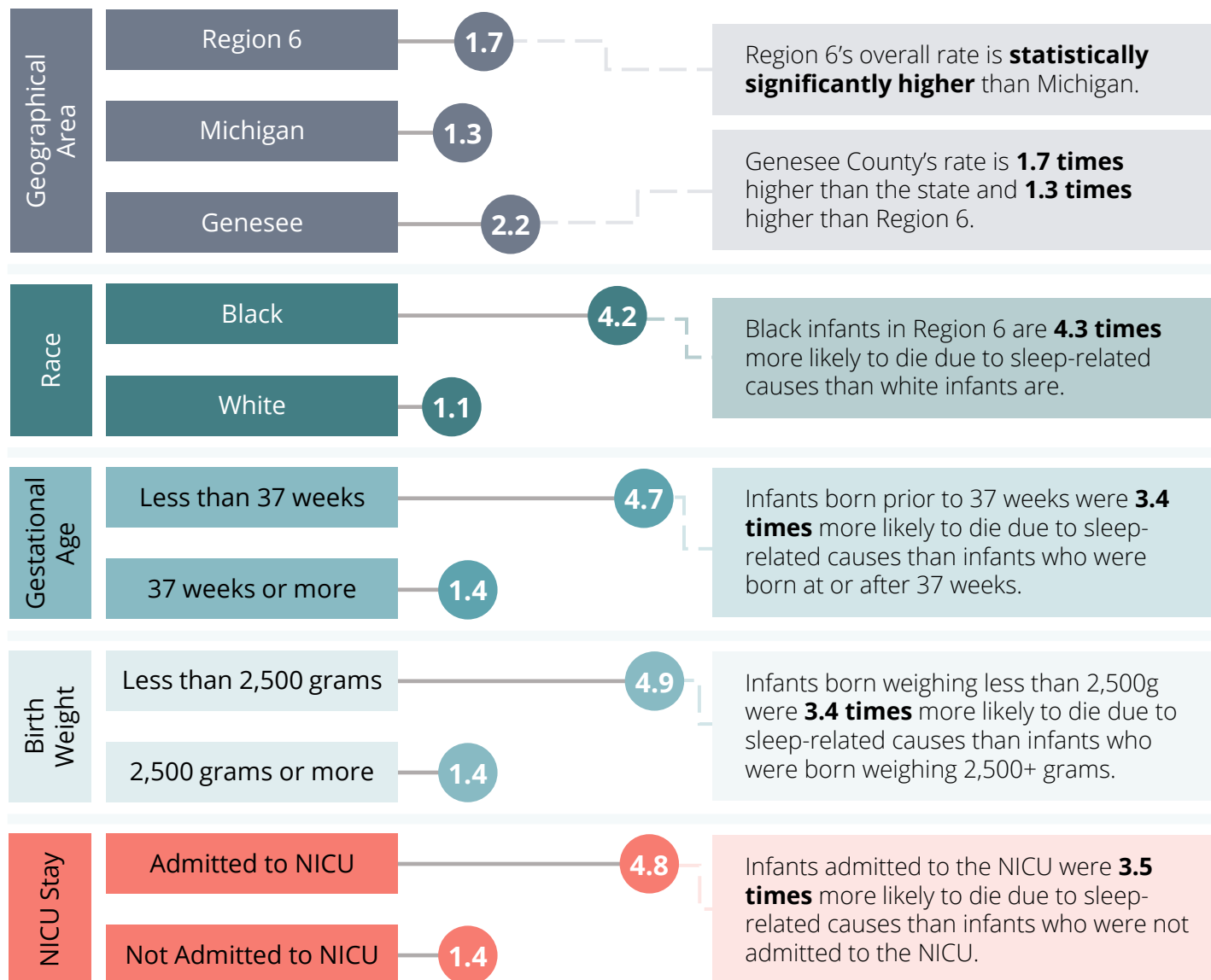
